Background:

The planning process is underway for The Alameda Neighborhood Business District (NBD) in San Jose to create a safe, attractive and revitalized corridor that will serve the needs of the surrounding community. More than 100 community members attended the first community meeting to provide input on a variety of topics that focused on issues around traffic, pedestrian safety and image.

The meeting on November16 will focus on the vision. Community members are invited to review and comment on the information gathered at the first meeting regarding assets and challenges along the street. Attendees will also have a chance to discuss their vision for the area and the priorities.

In 2008, the San Jose Redevelopment Agency and The Alameda community were awarded a \$250,000 State Caltrans Community-Based Transportation Planning Grant to begin a visioning process for The Alameda as a transportation-oriented corridor. The project will cover approximately 1.5 miles between Diridon Station and Interstate 880 and will focus on making a more pedestrian and bicycle-friendly environment. Key elements of the project will
