The West San Carlos Business District Association serves the business community of West San Carlos Street & Stevens Creek Boulevard from Interstate 880 to Bird Avenue. West San Carlos is a historical shopping area dating to the 1930s. As part of the Association's work to promote the West San Carlos neighborhood and its neighborhood-serving small businesses, the Association continues to promote the Luther Burbank Jamboree and Carnival, which has been a San Jose tradition since 1948.

Event highlights include a three day celebration with carnival rides, dozens of non-profit and community participation booths, arts and crafts, Mariachi performers, live music bands, food, fun, and dancing. The speaking ceremony will be on Saturday, October 16, and will start at 1 p.m. at the main stage.

The Jamboree is a free, non-alcohol event and a portion of its proceeds will be donated to Luther Burbank Elementary and Lincoln High Schools.

Established as a Neighborhood Business District (NBD) in 1990, the West San Carlos NBD area is known as Midtown due to its central location midway between Valley Fair and Downtown San Jose.
