Project: Alum Rock Youth Center

Description: The City of San Jose partnered with the Alum Rock Union School District to construct the 17,300 square foot Alum Rock Youth Center. Located on the Pala Middle School campus, the youth center facilitates cultural enrichment activities for local families and youth.

Benefit: The Alum Rock Youth Center provides recreational and educational opportunities for the East San Jose community and surrounding schools.
