**Project:** James Lick High School Parking Lot

**Description:** The San Jose Redevelopment Agency and the East Side Union High School District (ESUHSD) composed a shared parking agreement to fund parking lot improvements at James Lick High School.

**Location:** 57 North White Road (Northwest corner of Alum Rock Avenue and White Road)  
Alum Rock Neighborhood Business District

**Benefit:** The new parking lot will provide public parking during non-school hours and will benefit the surrounding neighborhood shopping areas and patrons of the future public library at the southwest corner of Alum Rock and White Road.

**Features:**

- Marquee sign
- Four new palm trees with up-lighting of the parking lot entrances
- 36 sycamore trees, a large elm tree, white roses
- Upgraded pedestrian entrances
- Green tubular perimeter steel fence
- Additional lighting

**Total Costs:** \$469,055  
    \$ 375,000 from San Jose Redevelopment Agency  
    \$ 94,055 from the East Side Union High School District
