Project: Northside Community Center

Description: The Northside Community Center is situated in Japantown, an established commercial and residential area. The center is located at Sixth and Empire Streets with several public art components including a landscaped garden. It is part of a mixed-use project that includes Mabuhay Court Senior Housing.

Japantown Neighborhood Business District

Benefit: The community center will provide a space at which the neighborhood can meet, enjoy its amenities, and discuss issues and concerns.

- 15,414 square foot community center
- Classroom/library/offices
- Auditorium
- Kitchen
- Underground parking spaces
